ARCHANA PURI, J.

The matter has been taken up through video conferencing in the light of COVID-19 pandemic.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 for registration of FIR against respondent No.4 under Section 353, 420 and other relevant provisions of IPC at Police Station Garh Shankar, District Hoshiarpur, on the basis of complaint dated 10.11.2020 (Annexure P-2) filed by him.

It is the grievance of the petitioner that he is working as Medical Officer, Civil Hospital, Garh Shankar and respondent No.4 misbehaved with the petitioner and as well as other government staff while they were on official duties in the hospital. Necessary intimation regarding the misbehaviour was immediately given to the concerned SHO vide Annexure P-1. Thereafter, the detailed manner of taking place of the incident was also furnished to SHO, Garh Shankar, vide complaint dated 10.11.2020, copy whereof is Annexure P-2. Even police had asked for the particulars of

the person who misbehaved and the same was furnished by the petitioner vide Annexure P-3 to SHO concerned. Despite the complaint having been so filed by the petitioner, which is dated 10.11.2020 (Annexure P-2), no action has been initiated upon the same.

Notice of motion.

Mr. M.S. Nagra, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and gives assurance about initiation of action on the complaint dated 10.11.2020, copy whereof is Annexure P-2.

In view of the submission so made and the assurance so given by the learned State Counsel, the present petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to consider the grievance of the petitioner, in view of the contents of the complaint dated 10.11.2020, copy whereof is Annexure P-2 and to initiate action upon the same, in accordance with law, if so required and dispose of the same within a period of eight weeks from today onwards.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.

However, these observations are circumscribed only for the purposes of disposal of the present petition, without prejudice to the rights of the parties, to be adjudicated in any civil or criminal proceedings.
