The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to complete the service book of the petitioner and grant him arrears of salary and retiral benefits and also to count the full service of the petitioner including his daily wage service for the purpose of retiral benefits and interest on arrears @ 18% per annum, for which, legal notice dated 06.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) has also been served upon the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly

consider the legal notice dated 06.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
