The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 not to unnecessarily harass the petitioner by calling him to the police station without complying with the provision of Section 160 of the Cr.P.C. on account of false and frivolous complaints filed by respondents No.4 and 5 and their associates.

Further prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from danger at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage he would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) to look into and take action on the issues raised by the petitioner in his representation dated 15.11.2021 (Annexure P-3).

I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner to be reasonable.

Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) to look into the representation dated 15.11.2021 (Annexure P-3), submitted by the petitioner and do the needful in accordance with law.
