1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.155 dated 19.07.2020, registered under Sections 376D and 506 IPC, at Police Station City Dadri, District Charkhi Dadri.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 03.03.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, gave his DNA sample, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned DAG, Haryana, on instructions from *SI Tufan Singh*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 03.03.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, gave his DNA sample, cooperated in the investigation, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the statement of learned DAG, Haryana, order dated 03.03.2021, passed by this Court, is confirmed subject to outcome of the DNA report. In the event of the DNA report being adverse to the petitioner, the protection granted to the petitioner shall come to an end and the petitioner shall surrender before the trial court. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
