The petitioner was appointed on work charge basis on 1st September 1981. His services were regularised on 25th January 1996 and he superannuated on dated 30th September 2015. However, while computing his retiral benefits, the service rendered on work charge basis has not been counted. Even legal notice dated 10th September 2020 (Annexure P-6) has not been responded to. A reminder dated 5th October 2020 (Annexure P-7) has also been given however without any result.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity of issuing notice of motion to the respondents.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Chairman-cum- Managing Director PSPCL, to decide the pending legal notice dated 10th September 2020 followed by reminder dated 5th October 2020 in accordance with law on the subject by passing a speaking order within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
