Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.124 dated 16.08.2020 under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered on the statement of complainant Shamnath, when he was selling the fruits and vegetables in his kiosk, three persons came on a motorcycle and after having a talk with him for 3-4 minutes, one of the person snatched Rs.450/- from him and all of them tried to escape on the motorcycle. In the meantime, complainant, with the help of one Gurwinder Singh, overpowered one person named as Bobby Khan and on his disclosure statement, name of the petitioner surfaced. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not

involved in any other case and is in custody for the last 05 months and 21 days and the investigation is complete.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of custody certificate dated 07.02.2021 filed in the Court today, has not disputed that the petitioner is first offender.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
