This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents for modifying and correcting the pay fixation of the petitioner, which was sent by respondent No.3 to respondent No.2, vide letter dated 14.9.2020 (Annexure P-3); and grant him the consequential benefits including retiral benefits along with interest @ 9 % per annum. It is further prayed that respondents be directed to decide his legal notice dated 31.8.2021 (Annexure P-5) within a stipulated period.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents pass a speaking order on his legal notice dated 31.8.2021 (Annexure P-5) within a time frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice issued by the petitioner dated 31.8.2021 (Annexure P-5) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioner is found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioner within a further period of 3 months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
