Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioners seek stay of proceedings before the trial court in case FIR no.84 dated 21.10.2016, registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 379/430/427/506/148/149 of the IPC and Section 3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984.

They further seek a direction to the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Fazilka, to advance the date of hearing in the revision petition filed by them against the order dated 4.6.2020, passed by the learned JMIC, Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that despite a prayer having been made before the learned revisional court to the effect that till the decision of the revision petition, proceedings before the trial court be ordered to be stayed, no order has been passed by that court qua that prayer, with the next date of hearing in the revision petition being

3.3.2021, but the date of hearing before the trial court being 2.2.2021.

That being so, this petition is disposed of with a direction that with regard to any prayer made in the revision petition for stay of proceedings before the trial court, or on any application moved for that purpose before that court, an appropriate order thereupon shall be passed by the learned revisional court, within 15 days from today, with the learned trial court directed in the meanwhile to adjourn the matter to a date beyond 11.2.2021 to await an order to be passed by the learned revisional court as directed herein above (including obviously with regard to any issue of jurisdiction that that court (revisional court), may consider).
