The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The learned trial court has allowed the application to bring on record the legal representatives of defendant no.1(late Sh. Kaka Singh alias Bakshish Singh). This application was filed by the deceased's widow and a son. The plaintiffs have filed the present revision petition alleging that late Sh. Kaka Singh alias Bakshish Singh has also left behind his married daughter.

While allowing an application to bring on record the legal representatives, the Court only permits them to be brought on record. While deciding such an application, the Court does not opine or decide about the respective shares or any other substantive rights of the legal heirs of the deceased. The purpose of allowing such application is to permit the suit to continue. The application for bringing on record the legal representatives is decided in order to permit them to prosecute or defend the case, as the case may be.

The trial court has allowed Class-I heirs of the deceased to be brought on record. If the plaintiffs have any objection regarding the same, they can file another application.

Hence, no ground to exercise supervisory jurisdiction is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
