The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0036 dated 15.01.2020 under Sections 120-B, 420, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Bhiwani.

The operative part of the order dated 24.12.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the allegations levelled against the petitioner is totally concocted. There is no privy of contract between the petitioner and the complainant qua the sale deed involved in the present case. The petitioner happens to be a seller; two degrees before the seller; who sold the land to the complainant. Besides this, there are no allegations against the petitioner.

Notice of motion.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 24.12.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jitender, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 24.12.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
