This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.206 dated 25.06.2020 under Section 21(b) & 27-A of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 06.01.2021, whereby while issuing notice of motion to respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel contends that the alleged recovery of 15.70 grams of heroin was effected from accused-Channa Singh and Baljinder Singh, who were arrested on the spot and the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused subsequently on the basis of the disclosure statement suffered by them. According to him, in the given facts the custodial interrogation of the petitioner may not be necessary.

Notice of motion for 06.04.2021.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by SI Kashmir Singh does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 06.01.2021 is made absolute.
