The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0015 dated 01.03.2020, under Sections 379-B, 353, 186, 224, 225, 427, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Ajitwal, Moga, District Moga.

The coordinate Bench of this court on 18.01.2021 had passed the following order:-

“The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Counsel for the petitioner relies upon order dated 10.09.2020 passed by this Court in CRM-M-14150-2020 titled as Sarabjit Singh and others Versus State of Punjab.

Adjourned to 27.04.2021.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is alleged in the FIR that the petitioners are the members of a gang which had an inter-gang altercation. He,

however, contends that the petitioners are in the early 20s and they are not involved in any other criminal case. He further contends that there is no MLR of any person, who is allegedly injured in the occurrence.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Faily Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 18.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
