SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1 In FIR No.760, dated 13.09.2021 registered at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar, offences under Sections 506, 34 IPC, and, also as submitted by the learned State counsel, offences under Sections 325, 379-B and 201 IPC, are embodied.

2 The learned State counsel submits, that the investigation into the offences supra, are concluded by investigating officer, and, that all the relevant recoveries stand effected, by the investigating officer, at the instance of the bail applicant-accused. Moreover, Mr. Ranjit Saini, Advocate under vakalatnama appearing on behalf of complainant-informant, submits that a compromise has occurred *inter-se* the bail applicant-accused, and, the respondent-informant.

3 The afore made statement at the bar by the learned counsel for the respondent-informant, is not contested by the learned counsel, for the

bail applicant-accused. The cumulative effect of the afore made statements, at the bar, by the counsels concerned, and also by the learned State counsel, is that at this stage, there is no necessity to order for the custodial interrogation of the bail applicant-accused.

4 Therefore, this Court does not deem fit to order for the custodial interrogation of the accused, rather grants anticipatory bail to the bail applicant-accused. Consequently, in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released, by the Investigation Officer, on his furnishing personal and surety bonds in the sum of ₹ 50,000/- each, before him, and, also subject to his not tampering with prosecution evidence, and/or not influencing prosecution witnesses, and, also his appearing before the Investigating Officer concerned, as and when he is required to be making his personal appearance.
