The matter is taken up through the medium of video conferencing.

Mr. Sumit Gupta, Advocate has joined the proceedings through WhatsApp call.

A consent form has been received from the office of Mr. Sumit Gupta, Advocate dated 17.11.2021, whereby both the parties have agreed for full and final settlement with the enhanced compensation at Rs.5,50,000/- (Rs.5 lakhs 50 thousands only) over and above the amount awarded by the learned Commissioner under the Employee's Compensation Act i.e. Rs.2,26,005/-.

The enhanced amount is to be credited to the account of the claimant within a period of four weeks from today. The claimant has undertaken to provide the bank details enabling the respondent-Insurance Company to credit the amount through RTGS.

In case the appellant fails to provide the bank details for the purpose of transfer of amount so enhanced here-in-above, the Insurance Company will be at liberty to issue demand draft against the said amount.

It is further made clear that in case the Insurance Company

fails to deposit the amount of enhanced compensation within the stipulated period of four weeks, it shall carry interest @9% per annum from the date it became due till the date of its realization.

The present appeal is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
