HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that after the death of the son of the petitioners, who was married to respondent No.8, the amount from the account of the deceased son, has been withdrawn by respondent No.8 fraudulently and after the said fact was brought to the notice of the police, the petitioners are receiving threats to their life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already approached the police raising the said grievance vide representation dated 29.10.2021 (Annexure P-5), which is still pending consideration with respondent No.2 and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to

decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 29.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners by respondent No.2 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the representation dated 29.10.2021 (Annexure P-5), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 29.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It will be appreciated that before passing the order, all the persons, who are likely to be effected, including respondent No.8 are heard.
