The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant increment to the petitioner as per Civil Service Rule for the services rendered continuously for a period of one year before superannuation of the petitioner and further directions to fix and pay monthly pension to the petitioner and arrears with interest @ 12% per annum, for which, legal notice dated 24.08.2021 (Annexure P-3) has also been served upon the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 24.08.2021 (Annexure P-3) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
