This is a petition that has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the FIR No. 228 dated 30.08.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 and 325 and 326 IPC registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner while inter-alia contending that the co-accused Govinda has already been allowed bail by the lower Court.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. H. S. Sullar, Deputy A. G., Punjab for the respondent-State and Mr. B. S. Jaswal, Advocate for the complainant have put in appearance through the medium of video conferencing and oppose the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner while submitting that the injury attributed to the petitioner is a *datar* blow on the left arm of the

injured besides grievous injuries on the person of the complainant.

After arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition and seeks to withdraw the same.

Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn, being not pressed.
