Petitioners have approached this court, praying for setting-aside of order dated 23.08.2019 (Annexure P -8), which is alleged to have been passed in an illegal manner without giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has alternative remedy of approaching the Debt Recovery Tribunal, this Court does not feel it an appropriate case, where the writ jurisdiction should be entertained and, therefore, relegate the petitioner to approach the Debt Recovery Tribunal.
