GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition, as far as his prayer qua representation dated 26.10.2021 (Annexure P-9) is concerned, with liberty to avail all other alternative efficacious remedies, as may be available to him, in accordance with law.

As far as the prayer of the petitioner as regards disposal of representation dated 18.01.2021 (Annexure P-12) is concerned, this Court deems it appropriate not to pass any order at this stage, as it is too early in the day and/or rather premature since the allegations regarding disproportionate assets have been levelled against as many as 8 Police

Officers/officials and normally investigation in such cases does consume substantial time.

Consequently, the instant petition stands disposed of.

The petitioner is, however, at liberty to avail all other alternative efficacious remedies for disposal of his representation dated 26.10.2021 (Annexure P-9).
