The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 54 dated 01.12.2020 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioners have joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ashwani Kumar submits that in terms of order dated 07.01.2021, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for

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custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 07.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
