On 23.11.2021, the following order had been passed by this
court:-

“Case heard by way of video conferencing.

By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no.404, dated 16.11.2018, having been registered at Police Station South Sector 34, Chandigarh, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Section 420 of the IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1924.

It is to be noticed here that the learned Addl. P.P. U.T., Chandigarh has submitted that as per his instructions the petitioner was in fact declared to be a proclaimed offender on 26.10.2021.

Naturally, if that is so, there would be no question of the petitioner being admitted to anticipatory bail, yet, since learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to determine that fact, (which I would find no reason for in view of the statement made by the learned Addl. P.P.), adjourned to 25.11.2021.”

Today, learned counsel submits that he having confirmed from
the petitioner that the petitioner has been declared to be a proclaimed person,

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he does not press this petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
