SANT PARKASH, J.

The instant petition has been filed for issuance of appropriate direction to the official respondents to initiate appropriate legal action against private respondents No.5 to 7 for criminally intimidating the petitioner and trespassing over his agricultural land. Further prayer is for issuance of directions to respondents No.3 and 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of said private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner and private respondents No.5 to 7 are the first cousins and having joint land, which was mutually partitioned between them. He further submits that when the petitioner was sowing crop in his field, private respondents No.4 and 5 criminally intimidated the petitioner and trespassed over his agricultural land. They also threatened him that they would implicate him and his family in false cases. Learned counsel submits that when the grievance of the petitioner was not being redressed, he finally approached

the respondent authorities, by way of representations dated 12.10.2021 (P-2) and 13.10.2021 (P-3) but the same are also pending decision. He prays that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.3 is directed to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner, within a reasonable time.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tanvir Joshi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and submits that he has no objection if an appropriate direction be issued for deciding the representation of the petitioner.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioner raised vide his representation dated 12.10.2021 (P-2) and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representation to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran for requisite compliance within the time period granted by this Court.
