**FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)**

In this third regular bail application filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 13 dated 10.01.2020 under Sections 20/61/85 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Civil Line Jind, the petitioner accused who is in judicial custody on the allegations of being found in illegal possession of contraband weighing 3.100 kg of *charas* has sought regular bail.

Upon hearing Mr. Rajinder Goyal, Advocate for the

petitioner and Ms. Ambika Luthra, Addl. A.G. Haryana and on perusal of the records.

This Court vide order dated 16.09.2021 has declined the same very relief to the petitioner and as has been submitted before this Court, petitioner is accused in another similar case under Sections 8, 20 and 23 of NDPS Act pertaining to State of Uttrakhand besides facing two other criminal cases under various stringent provisions of IPC. Keeping in view the fact that it appears that the petitioner is a habitual criminal dealing with narcotics does not entitle for grant of bail.

Finding no merits, the instant petition stands dismissed.
