By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail' upon FIR No. 252 having been registered at Police Station Sadar, District Bathinda, on 07.12.2020, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 61/78/1/14 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 01.01.2021 and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.
