Petition has been filed under Article 21 read with Articles 226/227 of the Constitution for the issuance of a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ directing respondents to show cause as to why the petitioner is being falsely implicated first in FIR No.40 dated 11.03.2019 registered under the Sections 21/61/85 NDPS Act at Police Station P.S. Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran registered against Saraj Singh, and the final objective of involving petitioner in FIR No.243 dated 29.08.2015 registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran and FIR No.36 on dated 26.10.2016 under Sections 436/175/201/202/120-B IPC, 1860, Police Station Vigilance Bureau Amritsar Range, Amritsar.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Kanwalpreet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Patti, District Tarn Taran has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1, 2, 4 & 5.

It has been averred that Inspector Rachhpal Singh has stated that he was posted as Incharge, CIA staff Tarn Taran from 18.02.2019 to 22.07.2019. During the above said tenure, S.S.P. Tarn Taran had asked him to check all arms licenses of 30 bore arms.

In such circumstances, the petitioner's arm license was got checked and the said official denied the fact that any harassment was done in the said checking process. It has also been alleged that the petitioner was falsely implicated in case FIR No.40 dated 11.03.2019 and FIR No.243 dated 29.08.2015.

Keeping in view the stand taken, learned counsel for the petitioner is satisfied that his grievances have been redressed.

Resultantly, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
