Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-4) dated 29.12.2020 in this regard to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Monika Jalota, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

The petitioners have placed on record copies of their Aadhar

Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) as proof of their age and copy of certificate

(Annexure P-3) regarding performance of marriage.

Without commenting on the validity of marriage, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 - S.H.O., Police Station Kabarwala, Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, that representation, if any, filed seeking protection of life and liberty, be looked into and contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is made clear that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court regarding marriage of the parties.
