The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 217, dated 24.09.2018, lodged under Sections 498-A, 406 of IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1).

In compliance to the order dated 20th August, 2021, of this Court, an amount of Rs. 10,000/- towards litigation, has been paid to the complainant, who is present in-person, in Court today.

Though the report has been received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court that the parties had arrived at an amicable settlement, however, learned counsel appearing for the complainant has submitted that differences have yet again cropped up between the petitioner and the complainant.

Vide order dated 20th August, 2021, of this Court, the petitioner had been directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Karnail Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and he is no longer required for further investigation, much less, custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 20th August, 2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
