Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-4) dated 28.12.2020, in this regard to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar.

On asking of the Court, Ms.Monika Jalota, Dy. A.G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

The petitioners have placed on record copies of Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) as proof of their age as well as marriage certificate (Annexure P-3) regarding performance of marriage.

Without commenting on the validity of marriage, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – S.H.O., Police Station Vallah, District Amritsar, that representation, if any, filed seeking protection of life and liberty, be looked into and contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is made clear that this order does not reflect anything on the validity of the marriage and shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court regarding marriage of the parties.
