The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents not to harass and humiliate the petitioners unnecessarily by making illegal raids at their residence.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer to the extent that his representation dated 16.11.2021 (Annexure P-7) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

At this stage, Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG Punjab, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioners. Let

sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 16.11.2021 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioners within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order, while adhering to the provisions of Cr.P.C., in accordance with law.
