Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.3 dated 05.01.2019 registered under Sections 120-B, 406, 420 and 506 IPC at Police Station B.P.T.P., District Faridabad.

Vide order dated 30.09.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

The order dated 13.02.2020 passed by this Court would show that the due amount towards the petitioner was Rs.10 lakh in total.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that out of the aforesaid amount of Rs.10 lakh, the petitioner has already made the payment of Rs.5 lakh to the complainant.

Learned counsel for the complainant does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has sent two post dated cheques bearing Nos.692586 dated 04.10.2021 and 692594 dated 21.10.2021, amounting to Rs.2,50,000/- each, issued in favour of the complainant. Both these cheques are ordered to be handed over to learned counsel for the complainant against proper receipt and identification. He further submits that pursuant to the order dated 30.09.2019 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Karambir, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
