SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to official respondents No.2 to 4 for registering an FIR against the private respondents No.5 to 9 keeping in view the judgment of Hon'ble Apex Court in *Lalita Kumari versus Govt. of UP and Ors, 2014 2 SCC 1* and also to decide the representations dated 30.10.2021 and 06.11.2021 (Annexure P-2 and P-3 respectively) submitted by the petitioner.

It is submitted that on account of enmity between the petitioner and respondent No.5-Mamandeen over land dispute, the latter in connivance with his family members/respondents No.6 to 9, gave several lathi blows to the petitioner, as a result thereof, the petitioner received total four injuries and his small finger got fractured. The respondents No.5 to 9 also threatened the family members of the petitioner. Consequently, the petitioner moved a representation dated 30.10.2021 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.4-S.H.O. Police Station, Punhana, District Nuh for registering an FIR against respondents No.5 to 9 and to take legal action against them. Since, no action was taken on the said representation, the petitioner moved another representation dated 06.11.2021 (Annexure P-3)

Now, the prayer on behalf of the petitioner is that a direction be issued to the official respondents to decide the aforesaid representations of the petitioner in an expeditious manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amreek Singh Narwal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and has no objection if an appropriate direction be issued for deciding the representations of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Nuh to decide the representation dated 06.11.2021 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representation (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Nuh for requisite compliance within the time period granted by this Court.
