Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct an impartial enquiry and take suitable action against private respondents No.4 and 5 as they have been harassing and maltreating the petitioner. Additionally, it has been prayed that a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 06.07.2021, Annexure P-1.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with respondent No.4 on 10.09.2005 and two sons were born out of the wedlock. He submits that at the time of marriage, dowry and expensive gold items as well as clothes were given to the in-laws and their relatives. He submits that the husband of the petitioner is leading an adulterous life and has been forcing the petitioner to divorce him besides making demands of cash from her. Still further, he submits that the petitioner has been physically assaulted by her

husband-respondent No.4 and his mother-respondent No.5 forcing her to leave her matrimonial home on 06.11.2020. According to the counsel, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 06.07.2021, Annexure P-1, to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala-respondent No.2 mentioning the atrocities being committed on her but no action has been taken thereon and the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the representation, Annexure P-1.

Request made by counsel has been considered.

Without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala-respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 06.07.2021, Annexure P-1, and take suitable action thereon, as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of this order as well as the representation, Annexure P-1, be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala-respondent No.2, so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
