The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider the option exercised by the petitioner for pension as a valid option as the same has been exercised on the basis of letter issued by the Government endorsement dated 14.11.2011 (Annexure P-2) as per notification dated 28.07.1994 published in the Punjab Government Gazette dated 29.07.1994 in which Municipal Corporation Employees Pension and General Provident Fund Rules, 1994 (P-1) further in terms of Annexures P-4 to P-6.
