The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to release retiral dues comprising of Gratuity and Leave Encashment along with interest @ 18% p.a., further a writ of mandamus directing respondents to release the payment of Gratuity after counting the period of Adhoc service in terms of mandate if Apex Court in Civil Appeal No.1254 of 2018 decided on 23.03.2018; and to decide the legal notice dated 01.11.2021 (Annexure P-4).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 01.11.2021

(Annexure P4), as representation and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
