This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed on behalf of the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.120 dated 02.09.2021, under Sections 307, 341, 148, 149 & 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station City-I, Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

[2]. Notice of motion.

[3]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Sewak, Additional Advocate General, Punjab to accept notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

[4]. At this stage, Mr. M.S. Yadav, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2/complainant.

[5]. Let requisite number of copies of the Paper-book be supplied to both the counsel.

[6]. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits *inter alia* that no injury whatsoever has been imputed to the petitioners in the FIR and the actual attack has been alleged upon co-accused Prince Kumar @ Pardeep Kumar and Mohd. Danish @ Sanju. Ld. Counsel further submits that the petitioners

stand on an identical footing with co-accused Mohammad Abrar @ Bablu, who was granted bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 03.11.2021 in CRM-M-45511-2021.

[7]. Attention is also drawn to the compromise arrived at between the accused persons and respondent No.2/complainant (Annexure P-2).

[8]. Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant admits the factum of compromise.

[9]. Considering all the above circumstances, this appears to be a fit case to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioners considering their parity with co-accused Mohammad Abrar @ Bablu, the present petition is disposed off by granting the relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioners subject to their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, they shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
