The petitioners have invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of certiorari for issuance of directions to the respondents to quash the impugned proceedings (Annexure P4), to order rescheduling the election afresh in a fair and transparent manner and to allow the petitioners to participate in the election; with a further prayer to direct respondents No.1 and 2 to take suitable legal action against the respondents No.3 and 4 for misusing their official power; as well as to decide the representation dated 16.11.2021 (Annexure P-6).

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the representation dated 16.11.2021 (Annexure P6) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
