This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition was filed seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to release the petitioner on parole for a period of four weeks to perform the marriage ceremony of his daughter i.e. fixed for 06.12.2021.

Notice had been issued in the petition.

Learned State counsel has forwarded today a reply by way of short affidavit of the Senior Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Insofar as factum of the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner fixed for 06.12.2021 is concerned, the same is accepted by learned State counsel and has been duly verified.

As per contents of the reply filed, we find that the petitioner had earlier mis-used the concession of parole and had surrendered late by 75 days.

Under such circumstances, petitioner is not entitled to the concession of parole for a period of four weeks as has been prayed for.

Be that as it may, considering the fact that marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is fixed for 06.12.2021, it is directed that the petitioner be taken to the venue of the wedding under custody on 06.12.2021 itself at 9:00 A.M. and thereafter be brought back to the Jail premises at 7:00 P.M. on the same very day.

These directions be complied with strictly by the Jail Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda.
