The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant family pension to her on account death of her husband-Zulfi Ram who had expired on 14.09.2019 alongwith interest @ 18% per annum, for which, legal notice dated 01.11.2021 (Annexure P-4) has also been served upon the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 01.11.2021 (Annexure P-4) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in

accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
