The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction to respondent No.3 – Station House Officer, Police Station Chabhal, District Tarn Taran not to harass him by calling him to the Police Station time & again.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the year 2013, the petitioner had solemnized marriage with one Harpreet Kaur against the wishes of her parents & other relatives and consequently, Tarsem Singh i.e. respondent No.4 had disowned Harpreet Kaur (wife of the petitioner). It has been submitted that ever since the marriage of the petitioner with Harpreet Kaur in the year 2013, they are living happily and have also been blessed with a male child in the year 2014.

Learned counsel has further submitted that now Harpreet Kaur's brother i.e. petitioner's brother-in-law (*sala*), namely, Harvinder

Singh (respondent No.6) has solemnized marriage with respondent No.7, namely, Taranpreet Kaur against the wishes of their families and on account of which respondent No.8, namely, Paramjit Kaur i.e. mother of Taranpreet Kaur has submitted a complaint in the police and the police somehow is now harassing the petitioner though he has nothing to do with the love marriage of respondent No.6 with respondent No.7. It has been submitted that although a representation dated 10.11.2021 (Annexure P-2) in this regard was made to the police, but to no avail.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards veracity of the averments made in the petition, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to look into the matter and to get the representation (Annexure P-2) examined so that the same is disposed of in accordance with law expeditiously.

A copy of this order along with copy of the representation (Annexure P-2) be sent to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran for necessary compliance.
