1. Prayer in the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant seniority to the petitioners as per merit in the batch, fix their pay as also release arrears of salary / allowances / notional consequential benefits along with interest in terms of the decision dated 10.05.2019 in CWP No.10469 of 2019.

2. At the outset, learned counsel contends that the petitioners have served legal notice Annexure P/5 dated 27.05.2021, on respondent No.2, but no decision has been taken in respect thereto till date, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide legal notice Annexure P/5 dated 27.05.2021, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.

4. Ms. Jasleen Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and on perusal of the writ petition states that she has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.
