Prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of a direction to the respondent to consider the petitioner for appointment to the post of Art and Craft Teacher, being eligible in SC-A category as she has secured 102 marks in the written examination.

Petitioner claims that she applied for the post of Art and Craft Teacher pursuant to advertisement dated 28.12.2020 in the Scheduled Caste Category. She took the written examination and as per self evaluation, she secured 102 marks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was called for interview on 14.03.2021, however her roll number does not figure in the final result declared on 14.11.2021. The last selected candidate is reflected to have secured 109 marks and eight candidates shown in the waiting list are reflected to have secured 104 marks. It is submitted that the petitioner having secured 102 marks in the written examination, is wrongly not reflected in the list of selected candidates, as she would necessarily have

secured sufficient marks in the interview to have made the cut.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State to whom an advance copy of the writ petition has been supplied, on instructions from Sh. Dikansh, Legal Assistant o/o Haryana Staff Selection Commission, submits that the petitioner has, in-fact, secured 92 marks in the written examination and 10 marks in the interview i.e., a total of 102 marks and, therefore, has not made it to the list of selected candidates.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, no ground is made out for any direction to the respondent, at this stage.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner has sought to raise certain other arguments for challenging the final result, however said grounds do not find any mention in the present writ petition. Therefore, I do not find any ground to entertain the same, at this stage.

Writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
