This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

As per averments made in the petition a project by the name of Anmol City, Banur was developed by private respondent No.6 upon approval and licence having been granted by the Punjab Urban Development Authority (PUDA).

Petitioners herein are stated to have purchased plots in the project.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that the necessary facilities/amenities such as metalled roads, water supply, sewerage etc. have not been provided.

Counsel would vehemently contend that inspite of numerous representations having been submitted to the PUDA authorities, no action is

being taken.

In view of the issue raised in the petition, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition at the very threshold and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to file a comprehensive representation to the Chief Administrator, PUDA, SAS Nagar, Mohali as regards their grievance.,

In the eventuality of such representation being preferred within a period of two weeks from today, the 4th respondent would be obligated to examine the same and to thereafter take steps as deemed fit and warranted in accordance with law.
