The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the balance payment of Rs.3,41,940/- as well as salary for extension period i.e. 01.04.2020 to 05.08.2020 to the petitioner along with interest and further to decide the legal notice dated 19.04.2021 (Annexure P-4).
