The petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant him emergency parole for a period of six weeks to enable him to take care of his wife who is pregnant by 30 weeks with the foetus having some complications as projected in the medical report dated 6th October, 2021 which has been appended with the writ petition as Annexure P-3.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that both the parents of the petitioner have expired and an application/representation has been submitted by the wife namely Suman, of the petitioner, copy whereof, has been appended as Annexure P-1 which was sent to the Superintendent Central Jail-I, Hisar on 3rd November, 2021. He further contends that no decision thereon, has been taken despite there being an urgency in the matter.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana.

Keeping in view the submission made by counsel for the petitioner and in the light of the prayer made in the application/representation which has been sent on 3rd November, 2021 through registered post, we direct the respondents to consider and decide the same within a period of two weeks from today and decision taken thereon, be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
