Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was manhandled on 11.09.2021 due to which, she lost her unborn child, for which act, an FIR No.262 dated 19.10.2021 registered under Sections 316, 323 and 509 IPC read with Section 34 of IPC at Police Station Chhachrauli, District Yamuna Nagar but, no investigation in the said allegations has been carried out by the Police, which has forced the petitioner to approach this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the fact that the petitioner had raised a grievance, as raised in the present petition, in the representation dated 28.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) filed before the respondent No.2 purportedly given, but no action has been taken on the same.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 28.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
