Through this third petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 99 dated 20.06.2020, registered under Sections 302, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case and no specific injury has been attributed to him. As per the allegation, the petitioner was armed with a base ball bat and no offence under Section 302 IPC is made out against the petitioner.

Though the petitioner was armed with base ball bat, yet there are specific allegation against the petitioner that he along with other co-accused

inflicted injuries upon the person of the Major Singh and committed his murder. As there are serious allegation against the petitioner, his custodial interrogation is required for effective investigation, no ground is made out to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
