HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed for directing the police to restrain respondent No.5 to interfere in the peaceful possession of the petitioner keeping in view the order passed by the trial Court preferred by the petitioner against respondent No.5 wherein, interim order of "status quo" has been granted in favour of the petitioner qua the house in dispute. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the sale deed was prepared by respondent No.5 in a fraudulent manner without paying any consideration and the said sale deed is already under challenge at the hands of the petitioner before the Civil Court wherein, an interim order has been granted in favour of the petitioner but still, the petitioner is sought to be dispossessed from the said house by respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already approached the police raising the said grievance vide

representation dated 11.05.2021 (Annexure P-2), which is still pending consideration with respondent No.2 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 11.05.2021 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner by respondent No.3 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 11.05.2021 (Annexure P-2), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 11.05.2021 (Annexure P-2) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It will be appreciated that before passing the order, all the persons, who are likely to be effected, including respondent No.5 are heard.
