1. Prayer in the petition under Articles 226 / 227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to count the service rendered by the petitioners on the post of SPOs as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary / retiral benefits, as already granted to similarly situated employees pursuant to order of this Court dated 15.02.2018, in CWP-9936-2017, in case titled as Sukhjit Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others.

2. At the outset, learned counsel states that the petitioners have served legal notice Annexure P/10 dated 18.02.2021, in respect of the grievances which are the subject matter of the instant petition and that the petitioners would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide legal notice Annexure P/10 dated 18.02.2021, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.

4. Mr. Abhaypal Singh Gill, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and on perusal of the writ petition states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties, perused the paper book and in view thereof as well as in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, dispose of the writ petition by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in legal notice Annexure P/10 dated 18.02.2021, in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter, including judgments Annexures P/4, P/5, P/6, P/7 and P/11, in case the same are applicable and have attained finality, within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
