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The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

As per the statements of the learned counsel for the parties, respectively, made before this Bench, it has been agreed that a sum of Rs.3,50,000/- (Three Lac Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal be paid to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal, by the Insurance Company. As per the statement of the learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount shall be paid to appellant No.1 and 2 in the same ratio as determined by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, within a period of two months. Appellant no.3 shall not be entitled to any compensation as ordered by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.3,50,000/- in the

name of appellant No.1 and 2 in the same ratio as determined by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court, within a period of two months, in compliance of this order, failing which an interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order.

The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall, after receiving the cheque, issue a proper receipt to the learned counsel/representative of the respondent–Insurance Company. The appellant's counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

A copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
