Both the parties are *ad idem* that the appeal can be disposed of by enhancing the amount of compensation to the tune of Rs.50,000/- over and above the amount of compensation awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal. The enhanced amount shall be paid towards full and final settlement of the claim of the appellant inclusive of the interest. Both the parties have given their offer and acceptance qua the aforesaid settlement.

Accordingly, in the light of understanding between the parties, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.50,000/- in the name of the appellant with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on the enhanced amount of compensation with effect from the due

date till final realisation of the amount. On receiving the cheque from the Insurance Company, the concerned officer/official of the Lok Adalat Branch shall issue proper receipt to the Insurance Company. The appellant/appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
